Class Definitions:

Note: If there is ambiguity about a car's eligibility, the judge's decision will be final.

Hot Rods – all years: The National Street Rod Association defines a hot rod as an "automobile of 1948 or earlier that has undergone some modernization to the engine, transmission, interior, or anything else. A hot rod is designed for racing." They are usually old or classic American cars with modified engines.

Vintage – up to 1949: Stock cars with period accessories, very limited modifications allowed.

Classics I – 1950 to 1959: Stock cars with period accessories, very limited modifications allowed.

Classics II – 1960 to 1984: Stock cars with period accessories, very limited modifications allowed.

Muscle Cars I – up to 1979: Large, two-door, boxy cars with large capacity engines, typically Dodge, Chevrolet, or Ford.

Muscle Cars II – 1980 and newer: Large, two-door, boxy cars with large capacity engines, typically Dodge, Chevrolet, or Ford.

Trucks I - up to 1959: Anything goes.

Trucks II – 1960 and newer: Anything goes.

Lowriders – All makes, models, years with customized paint, interior, and air bags or hydraulics front and rear.

Open – Anything that does not fit in an above category, including motorcycles, dragsters, tractors, Japanese cars, competition cars, rat rods, etc.

Trophies:

- 1. There is a minimum of 2 entries for a first-place trophy to be awarded.
- 2. One people's choice trophy will be awarded based on popular vote.
- 3. One discretionary trophy will be awarded by the Grand Marshal.
- 4. One discretionary trophy will be awarded by the Car Show Committee.
